THERE IS AN APP FOR THAT!

The IRS has a downloadable app for both IOS and Android phones called **IRS2Go**.

With the app individuals can access all of the same payments options available on the IRS website right from their phone.

WHETHER YOU USE THE PHONE APP OR GO ONLINE TO THE IRS WEBSITE, THE PAYMENT OPTIONS ARE THE SAME:

FREE OPTION

IRS Direct Pay: This is the **FREE**, secure payment method that allows for online transfers directly from your checking or savings account. This can be accessed through the **IRS2Go** app or by going to [IRS.gov/payments](https://www.irs.gov/payments).

DEBIT OR CREDIT CARD OPTION

Pay by Debit or Credit Card: The IRS contracts through three specific payment processors to allow individuals to pay via debit or credit card.

These processors and fees are as follows:

| PROCESSOR | DEBIT CARD | CREDIT CARD |
|---|-----------------|------------------------------|
| Pay1040.com | \$2.59 flat fee | 1.87% fee. Minimum of \$2.59 |
| PayUSAtax.com | \$2.58 flat fee | 1.97% fee. Minimum of \$2.69 |
| OfficialPayments.com/fed | \$2.00 flat fee | 1.99% fee. Minimum of \$2.50 |

Arizona

Electronic payments can be made via electronic check or a credit card at www.aztaxes.gov

Payments via credit cards are assessed a 2.35% convenience fee

Payments via electronic checks do not have a fee but the state will assess a \$50 fee for any returned checks due to incorrect or missing information

Colorado

Electronic payments can be made via electronic check or a credit card at www.colorado.gov/revenueonline

Once on the website select 'Make A Payment' under the quick links

Payments via credit cards are assessed a % fee based on the payment amount

Payments via electronic checks are assessed a \$1 fee

Idaho

Electronic payments can be made via electronic check or a credit card at www.accessidaho.org/secure/istc/payment.html

Note: An Access Idaho account will need to be set up to use this service

The third-party provider will charge a convenience fee to use this service

Iowa

Electronic payments can be made via a direct debit or a credit/debit card at https://efilepay.idr.iowa.gov/iao_aaa/welcome.asp

Note: An eFile & Pay account will need to be set up to use this service

Payments via credit cards are assessed a 2.5% convenience fee

Payments via debit cards are assessed a \$3.95 fee on payments of \$1,200 or less

Payments via direct debit are free through Iowa's ePay system

Minnesota

Electronic payments can be made via debit/credit card at https://www.mndor.state.mn.us/tp/payments/_/

On the welcome page select "No, I am not using a Letter ID"

Minnesota contracts through Value Payment Systems LLC who charges a convenience fee for this service.

Montana

Electronic payments can be made via direct debit or a credit/debit card at <https://app.mt.gov/ite>

The third-party provider will charge a convenience fee to use this service



North Dakota

Electronic payments can be made via electronic check or a credit card at <https://apps.nd.gov/tax/tap/> /
Once on the website select 'Make A Payment'

Payments via credit cards are assessed a 2.49% convenience fee with a minimum of \$3.95

Payments via debit cards are assessed a \$3.95 convenience fee

Payments via electronic checks do not have a fee

Oklahoma

Electronic payments can be made via Electronic Fund Transfer or a credit/debit card at <https://oktap.tax.ok.gov/Oktap/Web/>
Once on the website select 'Make an Online Payment'

The third-party provider will charge a convenience fee to use this service

Oregon

Electronic payments can be made via Electronic Fund Transfer or a credit/debit card at <https://revenueonline.dor.oregon.gov/tap/>
Once on the website select 'Make a Payment'

Payments via credit/debit card will charge a convenience fee to use this service

Payments via Electronic Fund Transfer does not have a fee

Utah

Electronic payments can be made via e-Check or a credit card at <https://tap.tax.utah.gov/TaxExpress/>
Once on the website select either 'Make e-Check Payment' or 'Make Credit Card Payment'

Payments via credit card will charge a convenience fee to use this service

Payments via e-Check does not have a fee
